- What did the coach do well this season?
  - 49 Responses
    - 37 Positive Responses
    - 8 Negative responses attaching coaches or simply saying nothing
- In what areas could the coach/coaches improve?
  - 49 Responses
    - 28 responses expressing areas that could be improved upon – anything from communication, strength training, listening to players, etc.
    - 16 responses left blank, stating nothing, not much or I think they were perfect, or would be nice if the parents would support the coach but that isn't on the coach.
    - 5 responses essentially demanding firing of coaches
- How can the activities office further support the program you are involved in?
  - 49 Responses
    - 14 responses left blank or I don't know
    - 24 comments regarding things to do better
      - Timely schedules
      - More communication/press releases
      - 7 regarding unhappy with new fundraiser policy
      - Other such as new shoulder pads, press box, artificial turf, educate coaches, discipline coaches, etc.
    - 5 responses asking for coaches to be fired
    - 6 responses related to things such as
      - Correcting parent behavior
        - As a parent I notice a gap between consistent communication from students about their sport actions. Then it leads to parents spreading the information which can often become misconstrued. Consistent and direct info from coach is needed.
      - Indicating how pleased people were and thank activities office
      - Asking activities office to keep supporting coaches despite what others may say
