

TESTING TRANSPARENCY

Opting out of Assessments

At the beginning of each school year, a LEA that receives Title I, Part A funds must notify the parents of each student attending any school receiving these funds that the parents may request. The LEA will provide the parents on request (and in a timely manner), information regarding any State or LEA policy regarding student participation. Any required assessments shall include:

- policy
- procedure
- parental right to opt the child out of such assessment, where applicable.

Additional Information

Each LEA must be made widely available through public means. They are posted clearly on the LEA's website for easy accessibility. Each school and grade level that is served by the LEA is included on their website. There is in depth information on each assessment required by the state, including:

- The subject matter assessed
- The purpose for which the assessment is designed and used
- The source of the requirement for the assessment
- Where such information is available
- The amount of time students will spend taking the assessment and the schedule for the assessment
- The time and format for disseminating results
